We therefore recommend adding that a target for tree canopy cover on development sites be set (the Woodland Trust recommends a 30% target), to be pursued through the retention of important trees, appropriate replacement of trees lost through development, ageing or disease in line with policy DD4, and by new planting to support green infrastructure (policy GI1) and biodiversity net gain (policy GI3).
