Bank Holidays and Start Time

From 1 April 2026, Biffa collection crews will begin working on all bank holidays except around Christmas and New Year. Collections will also start earlier every day, from 6.30am.

Recycling Centre (RC)

Extra recycling and rubbish, including real Christmas trees, can be taken to the RC at Metcalf Way, Langley Green. For opening times, visit westsussex.gov.uk

Excess waste

Over Christmas, we will take one additional, average sized sack/bag of rubbish for every day your collection is delayed e.g. if your collection day is normally a Monday, and we collect your waste on Tuesday, you can put one additional bag out for collection.

Please make sure your recycling and rubbish container(s) are **clearly visible, not blocking the pathway** and placed at the **edge of your property** by **7.30am** on the dates above. *Please note: 6.30am from 1 April 2026.*
